Description: The Office of the Public Defender provides comprehensive legal and related services to persons who are financially unable to obtain legal and related services. These individuals: (1) have been arrested for, charged with, or convicted of an offense punishable by confinement in jail or prison; (2) are subject to Family Court action; or (3) threatened by confinement in any psychiatric or other mental institution or facility.

The primary function of this position is to represent indigent clients charged with traffic and criminal offenses referred to the office by the courts. The applicant must be self-motivated and prepared to handle a heavy caseload. Attorneys are required travel to Lana'i, Moloka'i to attend court hearings. Litigation experience is preferred.
